


Lionel no. 12953

Two pairs of track switches

Locations like this add a
moderate level of peril and
intrigue to an otherwise
basic scheme

yard and any of the three
lineside industries

This route represents a
busy main line that
connects to points
beyond the edge of the
layout. Simply remove
one or both track
bumpers to expand
the line
